

Financial Aid Application Checklist for Transfer Students Entering Fall 2012 or Spring 2013

Follow the steps below to apply for need-based financial aid at Susquehanna for 2012–13.

STEP ONE

Complete both required forms:

A. CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE application

Complete online at <https://profileonline.collegeboard.com> as soon as possible after Oct. 1, 2011.

***Students entering in Fall 2012 must apply by May 1, 2012.**

Students entering in Spring 2013 must apply by Nov. 1, 2012.

B. Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Complete online at www.fafsa.gov between Jan. 1 and May 1, 2012.

Individual PINs for electronic signatures available anytime at www.pin.ed.gov

[Susquehanna's Code is 003369]

STEP TWO

Send **signed** photocopies of:

- Your parents' 2011 federal income tax return, W-2 forms and all supporting schedules
- Your 2011 federal income tax return, W-2 forms and all supporting schedules

Also send:

- All 1099 forms received by you and your parents to document 2011 untaxed income.
- Any extra forms required as part of your CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE application (e.g., business/farm supplement), if your parents own a business or a working farm.

2. File taxes and financial aid applications early.
3. Respond promptly to requests for more information.

5. Matriculation deposits for accepted students are due by May 1, 2012 for Fall 2012 and by Dec. 1, 2012 for Spring 2013.
