

Financial Aid Application Checklist for Transfer Students Entering Fall 2015 or Spring 2016

Follow the steps below to apply for need-based financial aid at Susquehanna for 2015-16.

STEP ONE

A. Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for federal aid.

Complete online at www.fafsa.gov between Jan. 1 and May 1, 2015.

Use your FSA username and password to sign the FAFSA. Both parents and students need one to e-sign the FAFSA.

STEP TWO

Send *signed* photocopies of:

- o Your parents' 2014 federal income tax return, W-2 forms and all supporting schedules
- o Your 2014 federal income tax return, W-2 forms and all supporting schedules

Also send:

- o All 1099 forms received by you and your parents to document 2014 untaxed income.

2. File taxes and financial aid applications early.
3. Respond promptly to requests for more information.

5. Matriculation deposits for accepted students are due by May 1, 2015 for Fall 2015 and by Dec. 1, 2015 for Spring 2016.
