

The following are instructions for mapping to a network drive on a Mac.

Prerequisites:

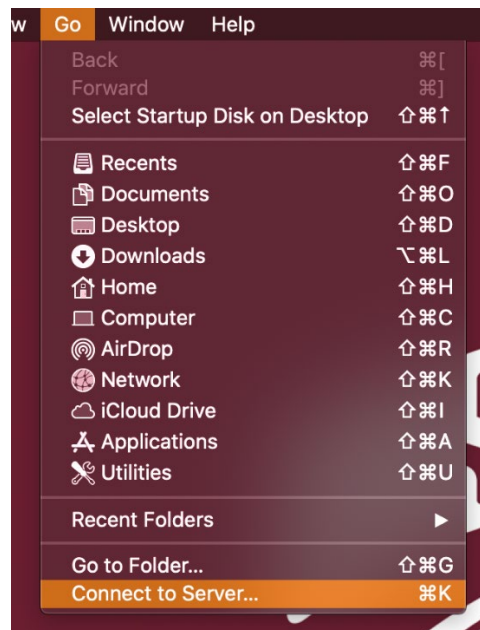
- You must have been granted access to any drives you are trying to connect to.
- If you are connecting from off campus, you must be connected to VPN.

System Requirements:

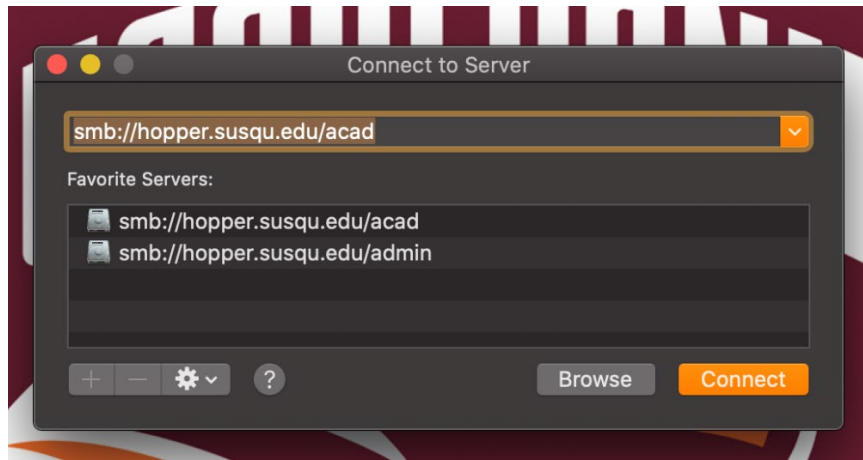
- Operating System: MacOS

Connection:

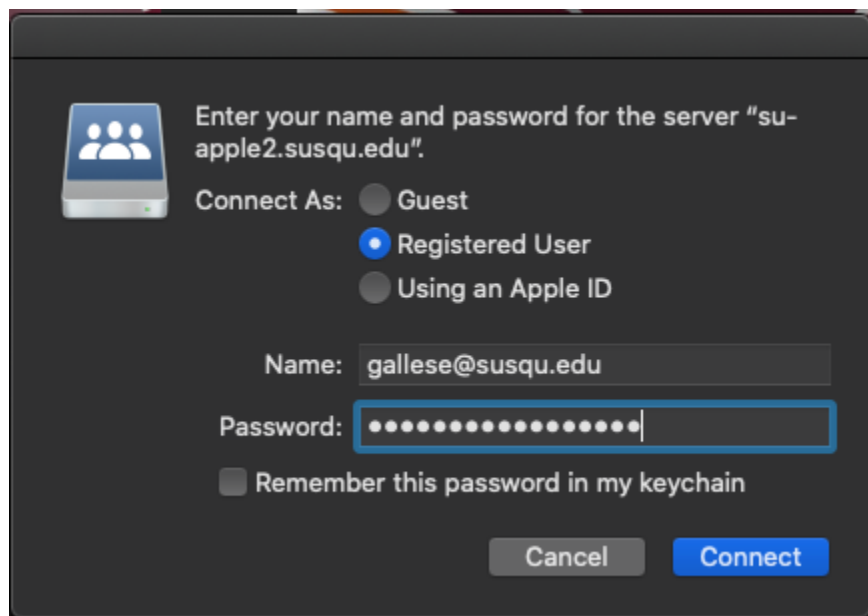
1. From the Finder toolbar, click “Go” and then “Connect to Server...” from the menu that appears.



2. In the window that pops up, type the address of the server you want to access. Common servers faculty and staff at Susquehanna use are:
 - a. `smb://hopper.susqu.edu/acad`
 - b. `smb://hopper.susqu.edu/admin`
 - c. `smb://hopper.susqu.edu/emphome/"username"` (Substitute “username” with your username, which is your email without @susqu.edu)
 - d. `smb://su-apple2.susqu.edu/Clyde`



3. Click Connect. You will be prompted to enter your username and password on the next window. Select “Registered User” and enter your full SU email and network password.



4. Click Connect. The drive will now appear in the “Shared” section on the left side of Finder where you can easily access it.
